

DIPLOMA IN RETAIL MANAGEMENT

The modules under WSQ Diploma in Retail Management are developed for retail professionals at the managerial level, who have a high degree of autonomy, possess responsibility in decision-making, and require knowledge and skills to perform a wide range of duties in a dynamic retail environment.

These include:

- Store / Outlet Managers
- Assistant Sales / Sales Managers
- Senior Merchandising Managers

To qualify for a WSQ Diploma in Retail Management, individuals must successfully complete:

- 7 core modules, and
- 2 elective modules

Alternatively, individuals may undertake training in an individual module or a collection of modules relevant to needs or occupation. A WSQ Statement of Attainment (SOA) will be awarded upon completion of each training module and passing the required assessments.

- Manage Finance for Retail Operations
- Manage Marketing Strategies
- Manage Teams
- Retailing and the Economy
- Manage Service Operations
- Manage Human Resources to Achieve Service Excellence

Elective Modules

- Manage Promotional Activities
- Manage and Maintain Store Facilities
- Buy Merchandise
- Control Inventory
- Contribute to the Buying of Merchandise
- Manage Staff Training and Assessment
- Manage Customer Relationships in a Retail Environment
- Manage Sales Operations
- Develop/ Co-develop Stores Security Policies and Procedures
- Setup a Retail Business
